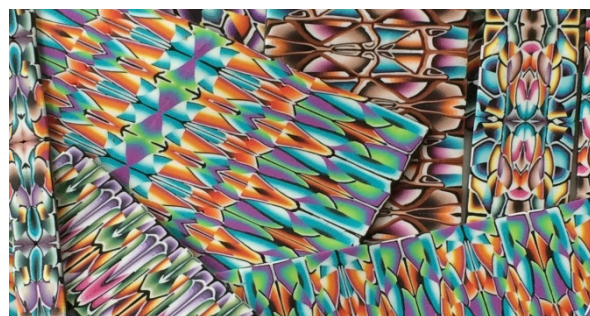

PATTERNS IN POLYMER - Friday February 17, 2017

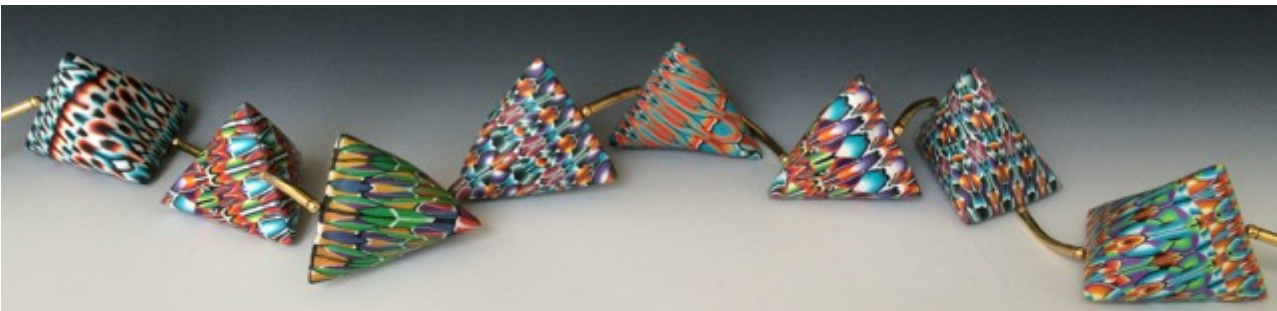


In this workshop we will make patterned sheets (veneers) using blended colors. The patterns look complicated but are achieved very easily. From one cane several different patterns will be created. We will use these veneers to make hollow tetrahedron shaped beads and large round beads to make a statement necklace. The veneers can also be used for other projects such as bangles and pendants.

CHOP AND CHANGE - Saturday February 18, 2017



This is a technique that can be applied to many projects. With just a few colors of polymer plus a little black and white we will make multi-colored striped sheets and then change them into several different patterns to create veneers for a variety of large beads and pendants.



Materials & Tools

1 block of 3 colors, such as magenta, yellow, turquoise. Fimo preferred choice

1 block of white and black

Scrap polymer conditioned to mud

Tissue blade - sharp

Pasta machine

Marxit tool or measure (for Chop and Change only)

Piece of white paper and a sheet of graph paper any gauge

Pen and note book

Smooth work tile at least 8 x 10 inches

Rolling rod

Needle tool

Pointed tweezers

Knitting needle for modelling (size 6 or similar)

Sharpie pen

Wet and Dry sand paper 400 - 800 grit and bowl

Nylon fishing line or cord and jewelry closure for necklace

Tapestry needle or similar for threading nylon

Spacer beads or small bead roller with bi-cone, round, oval shapes

Piece of denim fabric for satin finish or a buffing machine for a shiny finish (optional)

Small drill and 1.5 mm bits

A kit is included in class fee (a pair of 6 inch X 1/2 inch square wooden dowels, deli paper, deli wrap, a plastic laminated sheet for smoothing and 3 paper balls)

For round beads:

2.5 - 3 cms or larger cotton/paper balls (I will have some for sale)

Set of small round cookie cutters

Location: Classes will be held at the Holy Trinity Lutheran Church, 39020 5 Mile Rd, Livonia, MI 48154. Registration is open to active members of the guild. Class size is limited and will be filled based on date received. Registration is open from postmark dates of September 1, 2016 thru December 31, 2016.
