Workshop Description:

Saturday Workshop– *The Ripple Effect*

Learn an array of techniques to make beautiful beads and pendants using ripple patterned slices of polymer clay.

By layering, forming, and making angled cuts through layers of polymer, we will discover the versatility of the ripple blade and create unique and colorful jewelry.

Sunday Workshop– *Bangles*

We will prepare and bake a bangle base and decorate with slices from the ripple effect cane from the first day. For those attending the 2nd day only we will use the ripple blade to create a colorful ric-rac patterned veneer to cover the baked bangle blanks.
